- Signs on the laybys and passing places stolen on Wormley Hill Road. Email received DMBC to install
- Councillor Mr Fox requested if DMBC could install a power point on the lamp post near The Green to power the lights for the Christmas tree each year. Councillor White said he would look into this. The Parish Council are in agreement to pay any costs involved.
- Councillor Mrs Lifsey Reported on the new horse signs on the footpath. This sign has been confirmed it is correct and NO horses allowed.
- Councillor Mr Duckitt reported on the potholes on Wormley Hill Road to Ivy House Farm/Cowick Road. DMBC reported this would be looked into.
- Styles on the footpath along the Sykehouse Barrier Bank are in need of repairs. Environment agency are replacing these along with other works to be carried out and this bank area.
- Councillor Mr Fox reported on the road at Poplars Corner/Broad Lane and the road has fallen away into the ditch/dyke area. Making this part of the road dangerous to drive on. DMBC reported this is being repaired.
- Someone has shot the speed sign and caused a hole. This will need repairing. A quote has been received from Morelock who supplied the signs at £145 + £25 Return packaging. Agreed to sort this out ASAP
- Councillor Mr Duckitt requested lights for Wormley Hill in the new financial year. 3 posts could have lights erected on them. DMBC reported it would cost £1,500 per light
