

SYKEHOUSE PARISH COUNCIL

MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON THURSDAY 10TH DECEMBER 2015

Present: Councillor Mr Fox, Councillor Mr Lee, Councillor Mr Duckitt,
Councillor Mr Thompson, Councillor Mrs Lifsey & Clerk Ms Halsall.

In attendance: Councillor Austin White & Mrs Payling

Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting.

Mrs Payling enquired if any report had been received with regards to the complaint about Stainforth River Bridge being closed many times thru the year due to accidents and requesting traffic lights. This is the main route out for both Sykehouse and Fishlake and when this is closed it is a very long de-tour. Nothing had been received from DMBC. Councillor Mr White said he wold look into this.

Councillor Mr Fox reported on the gritting last year that was not done on Kirk Lane. This is not a bus route but many villagers in the area use this lane as a main route in and out of the village. This is a bad section and is around 3 miles long. Councillor Mr White said he wold look into this.

Councillor Mr Thompson reported on the fatality on A614 out of Sykehouse (Oak Lane). The condition of this road is poor and in urgent need of repairs. Over 150 Lorries also use this route.

Councillor Mr Duckitt reported on the large turn left sign at the end of this lane used to have reflectors on the post but now hasn't anything. Also 'SLOW' painted on the road had now worn off. This would help with the sharp bend. Councillor Mr White said he wold look into both these issues.

Councillor Mrs Lifsey reported on the recent traffic survey being inaccurate as speeding was bad thru the village, Councillor Mr White said he wold look into this as other villagers had used a DSD (Digital Speed Display) and would request one for the village.

Councillor Mr Lee requested salt boxes thru the village as there wasn't any at the moment around the village. Councillor Mr White said he wold look into this.

Councillor Mr White reported on changes to the street lighting changing to LED lights. So far this has received mixed reviews in villagers that have these new lights.

Councillor Mr Duckitt requested 2 more passage places at either end of Wormley Hill Lane and Rudgate Lane/Oak Lane. This was also a bus route and used by many haulage companies and the current passage places were not enough. Councillor Mr Duckitt said he was happy to meet for a site visit with DMBC if needed. Councillor Mr White said he wold look into this.

Mrs Payling enquired about the bus consultation taking place with DMBC and was concerned that the current bus would be taken off. This was used and needed and was currently only confirmed to be in place till May 2016. Councillor Mr White said he wold look into this.
