- Councillor Mr Fox reported on the road at Poplars Corner/Broad Lane and the road has fallen away into the ditch/dyke area. Making this part of the road dangerous to drive on. DMBC reported this is being repaired. *No dates received*
- Councillor Mr Duckitt requested lights for Wormley Hill in the new financial year. 2 posts could have lights erected on them. DMBC reported it would cost £1,500 per light. *Agreed for a site survey*
- 'Granby' on North Lane. Various buildings have been erected without permission and double skins around the current property. *No reply from DMBC*
- Speed sign repairs have been completed. Councillor Thompson reported he had received a donation of £140 to pay for the repairs. Councillor Thompson asked for Mr Kantecki to be thanked for his help in dispatching the sign to be repaired. Clerk to contact and thank.
- Church Yard is looking a mess and needs better maintenance and cutting around headstones. This has been reported by a number of residents. Clerk to contact Dorothy, church warden.


